Congressman Cecil R. King this week asked President Truman to bring to a halt the removal of the only Federal emergency medical supply warehouse in Southern California.

The warehouse recently was ordered padlocked by the Federal Civil Defense Administration because of a lack of funds.

King lashed out at the irresponsible economy moves of the members of Congress in taking steps which snipped the CD budget by two-thirds.

"Six million persons in the Southern California area will be deprived of disaster emergency aid," King said in his message to the President.






