Ease Draft Rules for Collegians

More liberal interpretation of selective service regulations for college students was revealed Friday by Forrest G. Murdock, president of El Camino College and the California Junior College Association.

Under a revised ruling by Maj. Gen. Lewis B. Hershey, national director of selective service, students may include non-academic courses in the minimum 15 semester units required to qualify for deferment, Murdock said. They may take part of their program in the so-called vocational courses, many of which prepare students for entrance into occupations directly upon graduation from the junior college.

In the past, 15 units of purely academic work were required to qualify for postponement of induction.


