**Lomita Blvd. Storm Drain Goes to Bid**

Supervisor Burton W. Chace disclosed this week that a call for bids to construct the Lomita Blvd. storm drain was approved by the County Board of Supervisors Tuesday.

Bids will be received up to 11 a.m. Feb. 26, at the office of the Chief Engineer of the Los Angeles County Flood Control District at 2250 Alcazar St. in Los Angeles, Chace declared.

"The Lomita Blvd. drain, estimated to cost \$965,900, is one of the largest capacity storm drains to be constructed under terms of the \$179,000,000 bond issue approved by the county voters in 1952," Chace said.

"This vitally-needed drain will absorb storm waters over an area of nearly 8000 acres, including the Lomita business and residential districts, the Narbonne High School, and the Torrance Municipal Airport," Supervisor Chace said.

He pointed out that the drain would effectively carry off storm waters which have, in the past, poured down from the Palos Verdes hills into the Lomita and Harbor City areas.

In addition to draining the Lomita area, the project will also carry off waters from the Walteria Sump District west of Hawthorne Blvd. when the proposed Walteria sump drain which will connect with the Lomita Blvd. drain, is completed, Chace said.
