Half of YMCA City to Sponsor Fund Reached Classes in Kite Making for Kids

Half of the money needed to carry on the YMCA program in Torrance has been subscribed, according to C. F. Mullen, 1954 support campaign chairman. As of Saturday, \$6,304 had been pledged from 175 different firms and individuals, or 17 per cent of the total number of prospects in the '54 campaign. Division co-chairmen reported the following totals: Commercial—\$1,361, Paul Diamond and Ed Raphael. Professional—\$1,110, Dr. D. C. Moshos and Al Isen. Field—\$1,604, Walter Inman and Bill Speck. Industrial—\$2,239, Otto Kresse and Gil Derouin. Mullen urged all workers to complete their cards and turn results in to Stan Roberts, executive secretary of the YMCA. Mrs. Ella Schwartz is presently organizing a group to call on persons who have not yet been contacted in the campaign.

Kite-making classes will be sponsored for boys and girls by the Torrance Recreation Department starting on March 6 at El Retiro Park and March 8 at McMaster Park, according to Les Breitenfeld, director in charge of the classes. A class will be held at McMaster every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 4 to 6 p.m., beginning March 8, and classes will be held at El Retiro Recreation Building on Saturdays from 10 to 12 noon, starting March 6. Boys and girls are requested to bring their own paper and string. Breitenfeld said. All other materials will be furnished by the Recreation Department.


