

# Cards, Cubs, Braves in Dead Heat For First in Little League Play

The Torrance Little Leagues swung into their third week of play this week with three teams still battling it out for first place in league standings.

The Cards, Cubs and Braves are all deadlocked for first, each with three wins and two losses. In second place are the Giants with two wins and two losses, the Dodgers are third with two wins and three losses, and the Pirates are fourth, with one win and three losses. These standings are as of July 5.

In Saturday, July 4 games, the Dodgers won their first league game over the Pirates 4-2. R. Vickers hurled the win for the Dodgers, and J. Oreskovich twirled for the losers.

On Sunday, the Cubs bounced the Dodgers 8-6, and the Pirates trimmed the Cardinals 6-5. J. Martin pitched for the victorious Cubs, but showed signs of fatigue in the last innings, as the Dodgers scored 3, 2 and 1 runs. E. Baker and T. Richardson pitched for the Dodgers.

For the Pirates, R. Boucher trod the hill, and K. Gates and N. Hartly were on the firing line for the Cards.
