**At General Petroleum**

**Pour 700 Yards of Concrete for 25-Story 'Cat' Reformer Base**

A solid block of concrete as big as the average house was fashioned in a single day at the General Petroleum refinery on Tuesday.

Seven hundred cubic yards of concrete poured out of transit mix trucks into a 75 by 48 foot hole to form the base of the newest processing unit to be added to the refinery.

The unit, called a "thermoform catalytic reformer," will tower twenty-five stories high and will process gasolines to improve quality.

The concrete was poured into the five-foot deep hole at a rate of over one hundred tons per hour. Most of the concrete trucks in the South Bay area were mustered for the job by the Azusa Rock and Sand Co., Torrance, who sub-contracted the job for the Bechtel Corp. Over one hundred and forty loads were used.

The base will support more than 1000 tons of steel, gasolene and chemicals when the unit goes into operation next year. The structures to be built on it include a reactor chamber where the gasoline and chemical catalyst will meet, a kiln where carbon is burned off the catalyst, and two huge storage bins for the catalyst.

Beneath the 700 cubic yards of concrete poured on Tuesday are better than a dozen concrete pilings which contain another 300 cubic yards.
