In a tour arranged by William Dewar, chief sales engineer of the aluminum extrusion division, and Albert Hinz, director of public relations for the firm, the students and a teacher were given a first-hand picture of the complete operation of this huge, privately owned plant, rated as one of Southern California's most prominent manufacturers.

The tour started in the employment office where the students were given identification badges and briefed on security regulations that Harvey management has in force to protect the government on defense work in progress.

Highlight of the tour, according to the students, was a scene of never-ending automatic screw machines, the largest operation of its kind west of the Mississippi. The mass production of aluminum extrusion, which starts in Harvey's own foundry and ends up in boxes ready to ship around the world, left the students open-mouthed.
