### Registration Date Told For El Camino Summer Session

Registration for the six-week summer session of El Camino College will be held in Room Two of the Administration Building Wednesday, June 30, from 1 to 9 p.m. Meri F. Sloan, director of student personnel, announced this week. Classes will begin on July 1 and continue through Aug. 12.

Commenting upon the summer program of El Camino, located on Crenshaw Blvd. between Manhattan and Redondo Beach Blvds., Sloan said, "The Summer Session appeals to high school graduates, college students and adults who wish to progress toward junior college graduation, to prepare for upper division university work, ready themselves for employment or provide personal enrichment and satisfaction."

"Somewhat smaller than classes held during the regular session, summer classes permit instructors to pay great attention to the needs of the individual student. Also, the student, concentrating on one or two subjects is enabled to use his time to great advantage," the director

elaborated, indicating at the same time that all facilities, including library and laboratories, will be available.

**Placement Exams**  
Placement examinations required of all students enrolling in algebra and English will be offered Saturday from 9 a.m. to 12 noon and on Monday, June 28, from 7 until 10 p.m. in Room 8 of the Administration building, 16007 Crenshaw Blvd., Sloan stressed.

El Camino College is a fully approved facility for veterans' education. Courses may be taken to further college work or to meet high school graduation requirements.

**Units Limited**  
"Students wishing to make up

high school deficiencies are reminded that three units of college work is equivalent to 10 high school credits," Sloan said. "Students are limited to a maximum of six units of lecture courses or five units of laboratory science."

Fifty-seven classes will be offered through the summer. These include instruction in the fields of art, biology, business, chemistry, economics, engineering, English, history, hygiene, law, mathematics, physics, political science, psychology, sociology, Spanish, speech arts, auto body and fender, auto mechanics, cosmetology, radio and TV, and welding.

The ship visited Hong Kong, Taoo, Formosa, Sasebo, Yokosuka, Kobe, Kure, and Nagasaki in Japan.

### Auto Shop Students Have 19 Auto Chassis to Study

"There's nothing like it anywhere else in the United States." This comment came from Charles Toynbee, auto shop instructor at El Camino College concerning facilities offered at the college for students desiring study in the field of auto mechanics.

Toynbee said: "Nowhere else in the colleges and universities of this country are there 19 complete automobile chassis and engines for experimental purposes such as we have here at El Camino.

"These stripped down autos are all in perfect running condition," the instructor continued, "and are worked on by students who receive the most practical of college training possible in the field of study."

"When we are studying, cooling systems, for instance, everyone has his own cooling system to work on. The chassis represent every popular make car to give the student varied experience in learning the intricacies of the different models," he added.

The investment in auto shop training represents about \$40,000, according to Toynbee.

Five auto shop classes enroll about 25 students per class. The course of study ranges from the basic parts of the automobile in

first semester, to transmission, which comprise the advanced training classes.

Next year, for the first time, a class will be formed to study automatic transmissions.
