Other Dana St. residents taking a vacation trip are Mr. and Mrs. Rappe and their two sons. Their journey is taking them back east to visit relatives.



First Trailer Unit Scheduled To Open in Fall

Construction of the first section of the new Rolling Hills Trailer Park at 248th St. and Crenshaw Blvd. should be completed by Sept. 20, owner Howard G. Miller revealed here this week. The first unit of the four-acre, 72-stall park has been under construction recently.

When completed, the new trailer park will offer three individual islands containing 30 to 50 foot lots to allow the largest trailers to use the facilities. All the spaces will be served by underground utilities, sewers will be in, and gas lines are available. Wide streets, large patios, and modern utility buildings including tiled showers will be available to trailer owners, Miller said.

The area will also be completely landscaped, and shade trees will be planted this fall.
