



E. Thompson. Calling upon all Harborites to make an effort to attend the program, which will be MC'd by "Queen For A Day" Jack Bailey, Thompson said this year's film depicts the financial plight of a family while struggling to save the life of their little girl, "Kathy." Thompson pointed out further that the film, concerned with the

functions of only one of the 164 Community Chest sponsored agencies "not only presents a fine appealing drama, but provides a candid picture of the extensive work of the Red Feather agency, as well as a clear account of the application of the Community Chest contributor's dollars."

Academy Award Winner Gets Recreation Post

Motion Picture Star William Holden, last year's Academy Award winner, Munday was appointed to the Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Commission by Mayor Norris Poulson. Holden succeeds former councilman George P. Cronk, who recently resigned from the Recreation and Park Commission, and his term will run through July 1 of next year, Mayor Poulson said.

ECC Awards Million \$\$ Building Bid

The first million-dollar building construction contract in the history of El Camino College was awarded last week by the college board of trustees for the construction of a little theatre, music and art centers, and facilities for the drama department. Successful low bidder for the combined projects was the Baruch Corporation of Los Angeles. Base bids for the construction range from a low bid of \$1,041,000 to a high bid of \$1,274,827. The Baruch Corp. estimates that it will require 300

calendar days to complete the project. In other actions the trustees approved architects working drawings for the construction of the swim gym and authorized a call for bids for this work as soon as the plans have been approved by the State's Division of Architecture.

Greg James Serving As Medical Aidman


