Your Dog On a Button
 Here's a new idea, boys and girls! Wear a button with a photo of your dog, cat or other pet on it. You can make this picture button yourself.

Look through Mother's button box for a big, overcoat-size button. Try to find one that has a hole through the hole to provide a means of attaching the button to your shirt with a small safety pin.

When you have selected a suitable button, hunt up a snapshot of your pet. Cut the head from the picture, trimming it so it will fit snugly inside the rim of the button as in Figure 2. Glue it here with fast-drying model airplane glue.

To protect the photo from becoming scratched through wear, cover it with cellophane tape (Figure 1). Use several strips, overlapping them neatly. Trim off any excess tape.


Your photo button is then ready to wear. People will be interested in seeing your pet's picture and will know you are mightily proud of it.
