Zestful Party Snacks Rate Hostess's Popularity High

It's fun to make casual calls seem like real party affairs, and it's easy to do if you have the makings for tasty snacks and refreshing beverages on hand.

Recipes like these for zestful snacks and spreads will be approved and enjoyed by your guests and certainly belong in your party files. All are suggested by Margie Ewen, Southern California Gas Co. home service representative.

CHEESE COINS

1/2 lb. nippy Cheddar cheese
1/2 lb. butter or margarine
1 C. sifted flour
1 tsp. salt
Cayenne

Put cheese through fine grater. Cream butter and blend in cheese. Sift flour with salt and a dash of cayenne. Work dry ingredients into creamed mixture and mix until smooth. Shape into two or three rolls about the diameter of a half-dollar. Wrap rolls in heavy waxed paper and chill thoroughly. To bake, slice "coins" about 1/4 inch thick, place on lightly oiled baking sheet and bake at 400 degrees for about 10 min., or until just slightly browned.

ANCHOVY-CHEESE SPREAD

1 pt. cottage cheese
6 or 8 anchovies, minced
2 tsp. minced parsley
2 tsp. minced onion
1 tsp. poppy seeds
Salt
Black pepper coarsely ground

Mix all ingredients, using salt and coarsely ground black pepper to taste. Serve on crisp crackers or Melba toast.

HOT CLAM DIP

2 3-oz. pkgs. cream cheese
1 7-oz. can minced clams, drained
1 tbsp. clam liquid
1 tsp. lemon juice
Garlic juice or garlic salt
Powdered cloves
1/2 tsp. monosodium glutamate

Mix the two kinds of cheese with chopped green onions. Add horseradish, salt and pepper to taste. Blend in mayonnaise to make desired spreading consistency. Put in bowl and sprinkle top with chopped pimiento. Serve on thin slices of pumpernickel or rye bread or with crisp crackers.
