SC Professor to Offer Course in Creative Living At San Pedro YWCA

Dr. David Eitzen, professor of pastoral counseling at the University of Southern California, will teach a course of special interest to women beginning tonight at the San Pedro YWCA.

The course is called "Sources of Creative Living" and is scheduled from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m.

Prior to coming to California, Dr. Eitzen taught in the public schools of Minnesota and following his A. B. degree honors from Bethel College, Kans. He taught high school in Kansas.

Dr. Eitzen, who is professor of pastoral counseling, is in addition president of the Los Angeles Coterie of Counselors, executive secretary of the California Institute on how medicine, psychology, and religion can cooperate to serve personality. He has served on the board of directors of the Los Angeles County Mental Hygiene Society.

During 1937 and 1938 he did research in pastoral psychotherapy at the General Hospital in Boston.

Locally his research has included a clinical religion project with the SC School of Medicine at the Los Angeles County Hospital. During his sabbatical leave in 1951 he conducted a

special project on group therapy for the rehabilitation of persons at the California Institution for Men at Chino, which had wide acclaim.

He is the author of "Productive Living" and "The Pastoral Counselor's Frame of Reference."

Included among his honorary and professional affiliations are his memberships in the American Association for the Advancement of Science, American Psychological Association, Western

Psychological Association, Southern California Psychological Association, British Guild of Pastoral Psychology and National Association of Biblical Instructors.


