Idea Brings \$1000 Check To Stillman

Ideas pay off. Charles F. McGahey, of 1503 Crenshaw Blvd., a stillman at the General Petroleum Corporation, found out this week.

A veteran of 17 years with the company, McGahey this week received a \$1000 check from Torrance Refinery Manager A. E. Thompson for a suggestion he made to enable the company to take coke fines from

the bottom of a distillation tower without shutting down operations. This method extends the "on stream" time of the unit between shutdowns for maintenance and saves the company money.

During the last 12 months, 190 other GP employees have received cash awards for suggestions, officials said.


