1955 Mercurys
To Be Shown
Here on Dec. 2

An entirely new automobile—the
Mercury Montclair—has been
added to the line of completely
new Mercury cars for 1955. Mak-
ing its debut in the automotive
field, the Montclair joins the
Monterey and the Custom series
which have been styling re-
styled and re-engineered.
All the new Mercurys will be
on display in dealer showrooms
throughout the nation on Dec. 2.
Showing here will be at South
Shore Motors, 1336 Post Ave.
Mercury for 1955 includes 10
models in the three series. The
wheelbase has been increased to
119 inches exterior dimensions
increased two inches in length
and two inches in width. Mer-
curys in the Monterey and Custom
series are one inch lower than
previous models, while the
low-silhouette Montclair is two-
and-one-half inches lower. The
rear tread is three inches wider
and the frame is one inch closer
to the ground.

New Bodies
The bold lines of the complete-
ly new bodies represent an evolu-
tion of basic Mercury styling.
A full-curve windshield provides
greater vision, and canted head-
lights give a forward rake to the
lower, wider front end. The
smooth-flowing line carries along
the side to a more massive rear
quarter panel with tail lamps de-
signed to blend into the overall
styling theme.
The 1955 Mercury offers two
high-compression overhead valve
V-8 engines to give maximum
performance at low and medium
speeds as well as better accel-
eration and passing ability.
