Youth Leadership Clinic Scheduled Here Saturday

"There's a tremendous difference between leaders of youth who are real leaders and those who are only instructors," Ben Solomon, New York editor and youth leader, has said.

Solomon, in the Los Angeles area for special training clinics with youth leaders, will conduct a one-day, two-session leadership training institute in the Torrance Civic Auditorium, Sat., Jan. 22, starting at 9 a.m.

"We have altogether too many instructors, workers in our youth-serving agencies who know how to work on metal or wood, who know how to coach a football team, but don't know how to train boys and girls," Solomon said.

The Recreation Department is sponsoring the institute for all professional and volunteer leaders and workers in any type of youth work.

Solomon is editor of "Youth Leaders Digest" and recognized as a specialist in leadership training. He is on the West Coast to conduct similar seminars for the Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Dept.

He spoke Monday night at Wilmington Play ground, on "What the community can do about its youth problems."

Mental Health Clinic Gains Told in Report

The Harbor Area Mental Health Clinic, set up in San Pedro last year on a one-day-a-week basis, may serve as the model for future clinics throughout the state, Dr. Simon Conrad, director of the State Mental Hygiene Clinic in Los Angeles, said last week in a report before the Harbor Welfare Conference.

More than 75 persons heard Dr. Conrad and two assistants, Dr. Carlo De Antonio and Dr. David Ruja, tell of the first year of the clinic's operation on a part-time basis.

The pilot mental health clinics conducted in San Pedro and Long Beach during recent months has been used as a basis for an Assembly bill introduced recently which would make similar services available to all California cities if adopted. Under the provisions of the new bill, state and local governments would share costs of the clinics.

The need for such clinics was pointed up by Dr. Conrad when he said that the number of persons entering the 14 state mental hospitals would be reduced considerably by such services.

At the present time, 15 to 20 persons are seen at the San Pedro clinic each Friday, and a waiting list of 40 persons is maintained by personnel of the service.




