### Lenny Smith to Represent City In Safety Run

The Torrance representative in the second annual "Junior Safety Run" will be Lenny Smith, of 818 Sartori Ave. Smith will drive the local car in the junior edition of the annual economy run, while David Duckwald, of Lawndale, will go in another car as an observer. The run will begin at dawn Saturday.

There will be 42 entrants in the run from Lynwood to Las Vegas, which is designed for youth to operate cars both from a safety and economic angle. Officials in the run will be Bill Evans, retired Torrance Police man and member of the Peace Officers Board of Directors, and Officer H. B. Ingram, sponsor of the local car club. The car which Smith will drive was donated by Oscar Maples Ford Agency, while the officials' car in which Evans and Ingram will ride was donated by Paul's Chevrolet.

### Measles Still Top Disease In This Area

Measles were still leading the disease list in the Torrance Health area for the two-week period ending May 7, according to the County Department of Health.

In this area, 103 cases of the disease were reported, with 29 of them in Torrance. County territory had 37 cases, while Redondo Beach had 19, Gardena had nine, Manhattan Beach had five, Hermosa Beach had three, and Palos Verdes Estates had one.

Other diseases in the area included chickenpox, 38; mumps, 30. German measles, seven; scarlet fever, six; whooping cough, five; gonorrhea, three; tuberculosis and food poisoning, each two; and epilepsy, hepatitis, meningitis, pneumonia, and syphilis, each one.

The city of Torrance reported nine cases of chickenpox, seven of mumps, three of scarlet fever, two each of German measles and gonorrhea, and one each of tuberculosis and hepatitis.

### RECORD OF CHEVROLET IN ROAD TESTS CITED

Performance of Chevrolet cars in auto tests, according to records compiled by the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing, have been revealed.
