Adventists Send Kids to School For Fourth 'R'

In an effort to add a fourth "R"—religion—to the three "R's" already taught in the schools, the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church has agreed to help support children in the Long Beach Elementary Church School, according to Pastor Glenn L. Goffar.

Children from this area will be supported by the church if they want to attend the Seventh-day Adventist School, which has students from all parts of the Torrance, Long Beach, and San Pedro areas, including Lomita and Harbor City. The school is also subsidized by other churches whose students attend the school.

The Bible is used as a textbook for religious courses, taught in Seventh-day Adventist school from an elementary level through college and medical schools. This year, 183 children are enrolled in the Long Beach School, according to Principal Charles Watkins. This is a gain of about five per cent over last year, he said, and reflects a 10 per cent increase in 4798 Adventist Schools throughout the world.
