

## Two Residents Find Old Civil War Newspaper

Two more Torrance residents got Civil War newspapers which are possibly quite valuable at bargain rates, they reported this week after reading the HERALD's account of how a local couple paid only a dime for a valuable paper.

Mrs. Lorraine Klingler, of 422 Camino del Campo, and Mrs. E. P. Johnson, of 2355 Torrance Blvd., each reported that they had old papers. They had read the HERALD account of how Mr. and Mrs. John A. Bodnar, of 18303 Falda Ave., had bought an old book for a dime, and found a July 4, 1863, copy of the Vicksburg Daily Citizen in it.

Several old Civil War newspapers, containing accounts of the War between the states, are owned by Mrs. Klingler, who said she found hers behind some old picture frames owned by her

family. Mrs. Johnson said her mother had given her a copy of the same paper the Bodnars found.

Both her copy and the Bodnars' is printed on wallpaper, but the color of the flowers on it is different.


**Gremminger Joins Navy**
