


Rev. Miller, Builder, To Start Big Project



REV. HOMER MILLER AND CHURCH PLANS
... Building Pastor Builds More

Rev. Homer Miller, who has made a life-long hobby of building things, will get his chance to work on the largest project of his career soon—construction of a new building for Hope Evangelical United Brethren Church.

The pastor at the growing mission church for the past two years, Rev. Miller is an enthusiastic woodworker, building all types of furniture and other things in his spare time.

Within the next month or so, his church expects to break ground for a new chapel unit addition on property at 8847 W. 174th St. The congregation now is meeting in temporary quarters on the same property.

Growing Church
Rev. Miller was formerly pastor at the Central Evangelical United Brethren Church here, before he was called to take the pastorate of the newly-founded north Torrance church three years ago. Since the church was started three years ago, it has grown from 12 to approximately 130 members. Sunday School classes include about 150 youngsters.

Plans for the new church call for a first unit, consisting of a chapel, classrooms, and a pastor's study. It will be approximately 80 by 80 feet. Future plans anticipate a sanctuary and additional classrooms.

The new church will cost about \$27,000 and will be built by volunteers, as far as possible. Since it is a mission church, it is supported to a large degree by the denomination. Some \$30,000 has been donated for the new building.

Love at Sight
Before his pastorate in Torrance, Rev. Miller served in Stockton. He came first to California in 1942 as an Army chaplain, and it was love at first sight.

"California is the greatest state in the Union," he declared.

A native of Pennsylvania, he had formerly served at pastorates in Harrisburg, Pa., and Dayton, O., before entering the Army.

A graduate of Albright College, of Reading, Pa., and Elizabethtown College, of Elizabethtown, Pa., he taught school for a time after graduation.

Asked to preach, he was the assistant teacher of a men's Bible class in Reading, Pa., when the pastor asked him to preach the sermon one Sunday. To his surprise, the pastor appeared at the service and afterward asked the congregation to grant him a preacher's license. Although

Rev. Miller had considered entering the ministry, he had not made the final decision to do so.

He later attended the Evangelical School of Theology at Reading, Ohio State University and the Chaplain's School at Harvard University.

Met Wife
As a member of a singing Gospel Team, he met the future Mrs. Miller at a rally at which he was singing. They were later married and had five children, four of whom are still living. They have been married 36 years.

Beside woodworking in his spare time, Rev. Miller also likes to read mystery stories, short stories, and poetry.

"Most of my sermons have at least one quotation from some poem," he noted.

The church today has a diversified program which can satisfy the spiritual and social needs of the people. If they let it do so, Rev. Miller feels. It has been a great contribution in helping to curb delinquency and crime, he feels, noting that delinquency is not necessarily restricted to children.


Entering the service in March of 1953, Pvt. Mora volunteered for airborne duty.
