Pool to Cost \$5000 More

Additional expenses in construction of the new municipal swimming pool were revealed before the City Council Tuesday when City Manager George Stevens reported that the contractor had found the native soil unsuitable for compacting as a base under foundations and the shallow part of the pool.

The Council authorized excavations deeper than the required footings to allow mechanical compaction and addition of decomposed granite under the foundations and shallow portion of the pool. The deep portions of the pool will be supported by piling, according to specifications. Additional cost of the extra base will be about \$4800, the city manager reported.




