### Holiday Cookies, Norwegian Style, Given by Mrs. Langum

A recipe for Christmas cookies, Norwegian style, is being offered this week to HERALD readers by Mrs. Milton T. Langum of 3832 Newton St.

Coupled with this recipe is an interesting story as to how Mrs. Langum first began to make Sandbakkels, the Norwegian name for the cookies, which are traditional in that country during the holiday season. Her husband told her before they were married that she would have to learn how to make these cookies, as they were a favorite of his. He was raised in a small Norwegian community in North Dakota. The recipe was obtained from his mother, Mrs. Lillian Langum of 1924 Andreo. Cooking for her husband has been a joy, according to Mrs. Langum, who proudly relates that he always thanks her even if his favorite dishes are not included.

The recipe donor is junior past president of Torrance Fireladies and her husband is an engineer with the local Fire Department. They are members of Central Evangelical UB Church and have two children, Michael John, 10, and Maren Kathleen, 8.

#### SANDBAKKELS

- 1 cup butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1/2 tsp. almond extract
- 2 1/2 cups flour

Cream butter and sugar—add egg, flour and flavoring. Press into sandbakkel tins or fluted tart shells until a thin, even layer is formed. Bake in 375° oven for 10 or 12 minutes. Cool in tins, then remove gently. "These cookies are very fragile and may be filled with whipped cream or preserves, but they are so rich, I usually serve them plain," said Mrs. Langum.


