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Mere Smoke Screen

Truth is not quite dead, even in Lomita.

May I give an eye-witness account of what happened with regard to Lomita at the meeting of the Torrance City Council on Jan. 15? The Torrance Planning Commission's letter recommending that the Council give consent to the circulation of petition in Lomita regarding annexation was read. A Lomita auto mechanic spoke in favor of annexation to Torrance. He had with him one service station operator and one real estate agent. None of them expressed any readiness to circulate petitions.

A motion to consent to circulation of petitions was opposed by Councilman Willys Blount, in whose district Lomita would logically fall.

A Lomita woman insisted on being heard and stated she wished "Torrance would leave us alone." There was one member in her supporting cast.

The third Lomita group present, numbering six, were there merely for information, and said nothing. They did not approve either the speech favoring incorporation or the discourtesy to Torrance. They left realizing that Torrance has no authority to authorize circulation of petitions outside its own boundaries, but merely to consent when the initiative is taken in the adjacent territory, and that the Council did merely consent as explained to them by the city attorney.

In view of the fact that the Tax Committee for the industries has unanimously opposed annexation of Lomita, the Chamber of Commerce has ordered an investigation, and the Councilman who

would have Lomita on his hands has voted against even consenting to circulation of petitions, it would appear that all the hubbub about Torrance annexing Lomita is a mere smoke screen intended to scare Lomitans into incorporation.

Lomita Group Names Mrs. Myers Head

After electing Mrs. Dessie Myers as president, the Lomita Property Owners and Registered Voters, Inc., passed resolutions opposing Lomita's incorporation or annexation to Torrance and asking for a change in the laws governing industry leasing of government land.

Other officers of the group include George Sands, vice president; Don Myers, corresponding secretary; Mrs. W. Carter, treasurer; and J. Albert, recording treasurer. Members of the board are Mrs. M. Cameron, Mrs. C. Anderson, Mrs. G. Glancy, Mrs. Tom Kabica, George Basily, Pete Thorsen, Capt. Henry Hansen, and Mrs. Lena Wells.


In connection with the annexation, Mrs. Myers pointed out that 25 per cent of registered voters would be required to call an election, while for incorporation, 25 per cent of landowners representing 25 per cent of assessed valuation would be necessary.

The group passed a resolution urging that letters be written to congressmen asking that the laws which permit large industries to lease property owned by the government and then be considered tax-free. Revenues worth \$77 million dollars are involved, Mrs. Myers declared.




