St. Lawrence Church Unveils Tableau

An original tableau, "The Holy Family of the Workshop," by Sculptor Fred Humphreys, was unveiled Sunday at St. Lawrence Martyr Catholic Church.

Msgr. Daniel Collins, pastor, said that he expects nationwide attention will be directed to the tableau, which depicts Mary bringing an eight-year-old Jesus to his father's workshop. It is the first public work of Humphreys in 15 years, although his works adorn many buildings in the Southern California area.

'Unreality' Named Topic This Sunday
