

Two Firemen Promoted After Policy Protest

Fire Chief J. J. Benner bowed to the protests of the International Association of Fire Fighters at a special Council meeting Thursday night and recommended the promotion of two previously bypassed firemen to settle a controversy which had threatened to rock the city's fire department.

Speaking at the meeting called for the purpose of settling the promotion issue brought up by the firemen, Benner said he would abide by the Council's expressed desire to see the two men promoted and would abide by all other policies set by the Council.

Promoted to captain as a result of the action were Engineers B. C. Blonker and Milton Langhin. The promotions previously announced by Benner for Engineers John Agapito and D. C. Minor were set aside by the Council. The eligible list expires tomorrow.
