The Bible

The longest chapter in the Bible, exclusive of the 119th Psalm, is the 7th of Numbers. It contains 89 verses numbering 1939 words.

Only three chapters of the Bible contain as many as 50 verses each. They are, Numbers, chapter 7, 89 verses; 1 Chronicles, chapter 6, 81 verses; St. Luke, chapter 1, 80 verses.

The 29th chapter of Job is the middle chapter of the Old Testament. Its number among the 39 chapters is 465, so that there are 464 chapters both before and after it.

The 13th chapter of Romans is the 130th chapter of the New Testament. There being 280 chapters in the book, this chapter forms the last one in the first half of it.

The 21st chapter of the Acts ends with a comma, the subject matter remaining unbroken by the introduction of the succeeding chapter. This is the only chapter in the Bible that does not end with a period.

This chapter is peculiar, moreover, in that it is not paragraphed.
