Mental Health Clinic Moves To New Spot

Addition of clinical services at the San Pedro Health Center has necessitated the removal of the Harbor District Mental Health Service to a new location at 111 W. Seventh St. in the Fox Cabrillo Theater building, San Pedro, according to the board of directors.

The first all-purpose pilot clinic was established in San Pedro. Future activities of the service, according to Mrs. Clyde B. Walsworth, coordinator, will include efforts to obtain additional area-wide facilities and services in psychiatric diagnosis, treatment, consultation, education, rehabilitation, training, and research.

The mental health service represents 22 referring communities in cooperative efforts to secure low-cost psychiatric services in the Los Angeles Harbor, Torrance-Palos Verdes, and South Bay area.

A five-day-per-week clinic been set up at the San Pedro center. It is open from 9:30 to 1:30, Monday through Friday, and the new phone number is TE 2-3447.

Funds for the new site were raised by San Pedro members of the Long Beach Legal Secretaries' Assn., directed by Lela Wick, president, and Mrs. Robert T. Martin, chairman.

A public dinner and reception, honoring Walter Rapaport, M.D., director of the State Department of Mental Hygiene, will be held May 24 at Harbor Junior College in connection with National Mental Health Month.
