## Three-Sport Player Tops Spring Dinner

Stellar athlete Dave Campbell, a three sport performer, won the North High School coveted Athlete of the Year award Wednesday night at the school's spring athletic banquet in the Cafetorium.

The senior star also was voted as the Saxons' most valuable basketball player. He received an individual trophy for winning the top award with his name inscribed on the perpetual trophy. For the basketball honor, Campbell had his name put on the All-American blanket.

Campbell was one of the bright points of a dismal football season as he notched second team All-Pioneer League honors at his end position. On the hardwood, he also gained prominence as the team's second highest scorer and a Pioneer League honorable mention award.

**Track Winners**  
Participating in the 100 and 800 in track, Campbell holds the school record in both events. He covered the century in 10.5 while running the half mile in 2:06.1.

Other athletes who were honored with All-American

blanket awards were catcher Stan Fittinger in baseball and trackster Chuck Richardson whose specialties were the 800 and mile.

**Top Golfer**  
Dave Scott won the most valuable player award for his part in North High's successful golf squad which finished in second place during Pioneer League competition. For the award, Scott was awarded a medal while his name was inscribed on a perpetual trophy.

The same arrangement followed for Bob Wyatt, who was named the most valuable tennis performer. Tennis was also a successful Saxon sport this season with the team ending up in the second spot. A special award went to junior Claude Stamp as the team's most inspirational player.

## Nation's Top Two-Year-Old Heads List For Hollywood Park Westerner July 20

Barbizon, voted the top two-year-old in the nation last year, heads a roster of 74 three-year-olds named to battle it out for the sophomore championship of the west in the \$100,000 added Westerner on Saturday, July 20, at Hollywood Park.

Standouts from all sections of the country were included in the list which Racing Secretary John Maluvius released today for the mile and one-quarter classic. The number was only six shy of last year's record total of 80 nominations. Such outstanding racers as Kerr Stables' Round Table, Mrs. Ada L. Rice's Indian Creek Ross and Klipstein's

Swirling Abbey and Llangollen, Farm's Nashville also were included in the lengthy list.

Mrs. Elizabeth Graham's Maine Chance Farm took honors for the most nominees. She named six, Jet Ex, Legal Crisis, Ne'er-Do-Wel, Winged Mercury, Wise Apple and Pocket Ruler. The last named is a half-brother to Gold Capitol, the 1950 Starlet Stakes winner.

## Swimmers Set Numerous Records In El Camino Pools Since 1956

Records set in the El Camino College pools since their opening early in 1956 have been established, not only by Warrior swimmers, but by prospective Olympic champs and high school water performers as well.

Individual records made by the Warriors, on the other hand, have been set in pools from Stockton to the north to neighboring Long Beach to the south.

Setting the records for holding the most Warrior swim records is Don McIlroy, whose top marks were established in three individual and two relay events. One of several McIlroys to swim for the Blue and Gray, Don was on the 1952 swim team.

## Local College Schedules Recreational Facilities
