A NEW DAWN . . . One might stretch a point and say Ranchero Days in Torrance were opened with a bang—in Nevada. Although the atomic device exploded in Nevada at 4:50 a.m. yesterday was rated as a small one—somewhere around 10 megatons—it threw a sharp flash of light

Expansion of Court Slated
