Osteopaths Give Approval To Plans for New Hospital

Preliminary drawings for a proposed one story, 50-bed Harbor Osteopathic Hospital received tentative approval Monday from members of the building committee of the harbor area group, according to Herbert C. Davis, of San Pedro, chairman.

Working with Davis on the committee were Drs. Chesley R. Houske, Torrance; Robert M. Patterson, Harbor City, and Kenneth A. Rascoe, Manhattan Beach.

Plans Drawn
Members of the committee have been working with Architect Maurice Metz, of Fresno, who prepared plans for the Sierra Osteopathic Hospital in the northern city. Drawings of the proposed new facility are scheduled to be presented to the California Department of Public Health special hospital committee at a hearing in Los Angeles Aug. 8 and 9.

Application has been made to the Department of Public Health for allocation of Hill-Burton Funds for the construction of the hospital. These funds, of state and federal tax monies, are available for build-up purposes as an outright gift, if the hospital plan is approved by the State Department of Health committee. Osteopaths have filed for a \$600,000 appropriation toward construction of the new, badly needed facility.

Committee Formed.
A special site and real estate committee headed by Harry Goldsmith, has been checking proposed sites for the Osteopathic Hospital which is tentatively scheduled to be constructed in the Lomita, Harbor City or West Wilmington area.
