### Louis Zamperini Will Speak At Hope Church

The former Torrance High star athlete and World War II hero will tell about his 47 days on a life raft and his conversion. While at Torrance High School, he set a mile record in interscholastic track competition which stood for 16 years.

He represented Torrance in the 1936 Olympic Games in Berlin. During World War II, he was a navigator captain in the Army Air Force and was shot down, spending 47 days on a life raft before he was captured and interned by the Japanese.

He was converted by Billy Graham in a tent revival in 1949, and since that time, has been active in Youth for Christ and in work to prevent juvenile delinquency.

At the churches evening services, Mrs. Ethel Long, child evangelism director for the South Bay area, will speak and show slides on the work.
