The San Diego Freeway will move a little closer to Torrance when a new section for which the contract was let this week is completed.

A State Public Work Dept. awarded a \$5,478,745 contract for construction of a new eight-lane section running 3.6 miles between Venice Blvd. in Culver City to Ohio Ave. in West Los Angeles. Construction has been scheduled for the freeway from Saugus to Venice Blvd., but the portion from Culver City south through Torrance and Long Beach still is only on paper.
