Tackle busting albacore are giving deep sea anglers a real run for their money as schools of the most popular game fish cut down traveling time to five hours, working between Catalina and San Clemente Islands. A break for fishermen, who have up until now have made the chase away the other side of the east end of San Clemente.

Joe Martin's San Pedro Landing stated fishing red hot with lunkers by the sackful (one or two to a sack considering size) checked in. Last week the weekly winner in Martin's derby was a Beverly Hills chap answering to Gene Cornwall. Topper long fin hit 34 pounds 8 ounces. Al Coast set the pace for this week, lunker brought one to gaff Monday aboard the Sharpshooter that sunk the scales to 36 pounds 2 ounces.

Pacific Sportfishing Landings' half-day boat racked up good takes of white sea bass off the Horseshoe. Lots of 30 pounders with a 49 pound 8 ounce beauty the largest checked in. Week end fishing on the horseshoe was for the birds, school still around as Monday's morning run yielded six along with a smattering of barracuda. Just like everyone else at present, Pacific's albacore runs are hitting fish about five hours out.

Only about four and a half weeks left in the annual San Diego Yellowtail Derby. As of Monday qualifying weight hit an all time high of 28 1/2 pounds. Fishing red hot at the border city, yellowtail and albacore competing for the lime light. Actually, outshining both is the rare catch of dolphin. 175 speed demons taken by the San Diego fleet to date for the season. Topper brought to gaff by a San Diegoan hitting 28 pounds 12 ounces. On a larger scale, the San Diego Marlin Club have recorded 95 bill fish to date. With just about every kind of fish available breaking records and busting tackle, here too is expected new entries in the history book.

Local waters also are making a good showing of the larger game fish. As yet not to much action as sport fishermen continue on albacore runs. Regardless, several hooked and a few landed while trolling for long fin. A fellow over at Union Carbide named Olson tangled with a beauty using 40 pound mono and a No. 2 hook. Battle raged for four
