Miss Hutchison, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harold E. Hutchison, is going to the Bethlehem Center, a Methodist community center in Spartanburg, S. C., as a social group worker.

The young home missionaries, known as "US-2's", represent 18 states. On Aug. 31 they completed six weeks of specialized training at Scarritt College for Christian Workers, Nashville, Tenn., in preparation for their work.

Over 400 courses in the seven divisions of the college will begin Tuesday, Sept. 17. All courses are tuition-free, carry regular college credit, and will be offered during the hours from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m., Monday through Fridays. A complete schedule of all classes is available and may be obtained by calling at the college.

Any person capable of profiting from attending college who is 18 years of age or older, or a high school graduate under 18, is eligible to attend Harbor Junior College, which is fully accredited for veterans, for transfer students, and for technical trainees.


