

FIRST AID REFRESHER CLASS SET

Red Cross first aid instructors of Torrance today were advised of the scheduling of an orientation class aimed to bring them "up-to-date" on the new methods of teaching the streamlined course as outlined in the Revised Red Cross First Aid textbook.

Announcement of the class — open only to holders of first aid instructors' certificates — was made by Stanley Remel-

meyer, volunteer chairman of the Torrance Red Cross Branch.

"The new first aid textbook marks the first change in Red Cross instruction of the skill since the outbreak of World War II," Remelmeier explained. "And following the re-training of our area instructors, Red Cross will immediately slate a series of first aid

classes so that residents of this city can have the opportunity to prepare themselves to act in event of any emergency."

Local first aid instructors may avail themselves of this new training by arranging to attend classes scheduled to be held at the Torrance High School on Thursday, Oct. 10; Thursday, Oct. 17; and Thursday, Oct. 24.
