Warriors Open Against Phoenix Saturday Night

Gathering their forces for Saturday night's home fray against the Bears of Phoenix, the El Camino College Warriors are a wiser squad today following schooling given them Saturday night by the "old grads."

In administering the pre-season lesson, the Alums blanked the '57 Warrior edition 27-0 and brought the record of scrimmages to a 4-4 tie.

Quarterback Paul Held demonstrated his professional ability in tossing three touchdown passes to as many eager receivers, two of whom cavorted for the Golden Bears of California last season, ends Norm Becker and Jim Carmichael. Becker received the trophy presented annually to the outstanding Alum lineman, while Held nabbed similar honors as the outstanding back of the game. Third of the scoring ends was Bill Autrey, another Warrior great.

Quarterback Larry Manly, back after being out for the season with a shoulder injury last fall, received the kick-off, returning it five yards. After a short exchange of kicks, the Varsity took over on its own 25. Manly's pass was intercepted by Roy Carver, who ran the ball over for the first tally early in the scrimmage. Ed Schoolcraft converted. Carver, who had watched Varsity workouts last week, was primed for his interception.

The Warrior's lone flash of glory was extinguished immediately when a 78-yard run across the goal by Manly was called back because of a clipping penalty.

The Warriors will put the lessons learned in the Alum scrimmage to use on their home field Saturday, when they attempt to make it three in a row against Phoenix.
