Thief Totos 420 lbs. Of Forgings Away

Police are searching today for the culprit who took 420 pounds of aluminum forgings, Glide Easy Mfg., 551 Arlington Ave., reported that the 12 forgings, each weighing 35 pounds, were missing. Value of the missing items was set at \$2133 by company officials.

The California Public Utilities Commission Wednesday okayed an additional gross revenue of \$18,240,000 a year for the Southern California Gas Co. The figure approved was \$1.7 million less than the company had sought.

Reason for the increase was that the company will pay increased taxes of about \$10 million a year, with the remainder to be used for capital funds in expansion of the rapidly growing service and other

increased prices. The decision, which followed 10 days of public hearings, will raise general service rates by about 11 per cent, compared with 11.26 per cent sought by the company. Originally, the firm had sought increases nearly twice as high.
