Osteopaths Will Begin Drive for Hospital Friday


Assemblyman Vincent Thomas of San Pedro, Los Angeles City Council President John Gibson, and Supervisor Burton Chace are among special guests invited to attend a "kick-off" banquet for the Bay Harbor Osteopathic Hospital fund drive Friday night at the Redondo Beach Elks Club. Dr. Merle Boyce, Redondo Beach, chairman, said other invited guests will include city officials, and civic leaders of the Bay-Harbor area communities. Assemblyman Thomas is honorary fund drive chairman for the proposed 50-bed, \$943,000 Bay-Harbor Osteopathic Hospital. Advance gifts for the new hospital have provided more than one half of the \$343,000 participating share and land cost goal which has been set for the area. The banquet Friday night is designed to stimulate a final 40-day stepped-up drive to raise the remaining funds needed to enable the district to acquire a \$594,882 grant of state and federal tax monies allocated to the hospital under the Hill-Burton fund. The area has only until Dec. 9 to raise the participating money to qualify for the Hill-Burton grant, according to Dr. George Wall, San Pedro, fund drive general chairman.
