## 49ers EYE EASY WIN OVER RAMS

A quintet of professional football players—who collectively might not make a bad starting lineup in the National Basketball Assn.—will lead the rollicking San Francisco 49ers into battle Sunday against the Rams at the Los Angeles Coliseum.

And, given a good weather break, a crowd in the neighborhood of 85,000 may be on hand to see if Coach Sid Gillman's crew can snap the 49er winning skein which has now reached five straight.

This totally unsuspected surge by the Bay area team, which now finds them two games in front of the pack in the Western Conference title chase, has been directed by a basketball-type passing attack featuring the redoubtable Y. A. Tittle on the throwing end and Hugh McElhenny, Chuck Con-

nor, Billy Wilson and R. C. Owens doing the catching. While the entire 49er squad has been amazing, these five in particular have been responsible for one thrilling victory after another.

It was Owens—the spectacular rookie from the College of Idaho—who turned what seemed to be certain defeat into victory last Sunday when he jumped high in the end zone to steal a pass from two Detroit defenders in the last 11 seconds. It marked the third time in six games that "impossible" catches in the dying

moments of the game by the former collegiate basketball star proved the winning margin for the Bay Area team.


