**SCOUT GOOD TURN DAY SCHEDULED FOR DEC. 7**

Al J. Gock, retired chairman of the board of directors of the Bank of America, has accepted chairmanship of the Good Turn Day, which will be held Saturday, Dec. 7. On that date 150,000 Boy Scouts will pick up bags which they had previously asked householders to fill with used clothing.

Last year 265,000 pounds of clothing and household articles were collected by Boy Scouts of the Los Angeles Area Council, San Fernando Valley Council, Verdugo Hills Council, Crescent Bay Council and San Gabriel Valley Council.

The clothing collected is distributed equally between four cooperating agencies: the Salvation Army, Goodwill Industries, St. Vincent De Paul Society, and the Volunteers of America. The material keeps thousands of physically handicapped people employed renovating it during the winter months, making possible a new chance for workers who are unemployable in other capacities. The clothing is also given to needy people by the agencies.

Through the Boy Scouts' Good Turn project, wasted manpower and wasted commodities are brought together, representing several million dollars value in social improve-
