SUPPORT SOUGHT FOR 'OPERATION OUTDOORS'

Support for "Operation Outdoors" was urged by the California State Chamber of Commerce in a statement released from Joseph R. Knowland, chairman of the chamber's Travel and Recreation Committee.

"Operation Outdoors," the national program aimed at meeting growing demands for family outdoor recreation in national forests calls for an expenditure of \$85,000,000 over the 1958-1962 period. The portion required by California Forests is \$15,000,000, an annual average expenditure of \$3,000,000. The five-year total for national forests in California is one-fourth of the amount allocated for State beaches and parks during the same period.

Funds Cut
Action recently taken by Congress to cut the \$85,000,000 national allocation 20 per cent, with each region sharing proportionately, will be felt directly in construction and rehabilitation of camp sites and picnic areas, the statement said.

"Today there are fewer National Forest camp and picnic grounds in the California Region than in the years prior to World War II," Knowland pointed out. "Then there were 11,000 family units as compared to 9800 early this past summer."

"California increase during that period is well known, but its rate is well below that of the surge in the mountains for picnics and camping, as well as other forms of outdoor recreation," he said.

Increase Seen
Use of the 18 national forests in California is expected to increase from eight million visits in 1956 to 12 million visits by 1962, or a 50 per cent increase.

"Since all of the major forest uses are affected adversely by an inadequate recreation plan, the lack of funds has serious overtones in the development of quality water, timber, and forage."

"The State Chamber will seek cooperation and aid in other states faced with similar problems on National Forest lands," Knowland said.
