

SPACE TECHNOLOGY LAB PLANNED BY COMPANY

Establishment of the Space Technology Laboratories as an autonomous operating division of the Ramo-Woodbridge Corp. was announced today by Dean E. Woodbridge, president.

The new division is an outgrowth and extension of the former guided missile research division, a unit of the company responsible for the technical direction and systems engineering for the Air Force ballistic missile program Atlas, Titan and Thor missiles.

Transfer Made
Space Technology Laboratories will have its own completely separate personnel, facilities and services, according to Dr. Woodbridge. Transfer to the laboratories of certain additional research facilities, technical and administrative supporting services previously provided on a company-wide basis, is also planned. In addition, transfer of several top R-W scientists and technical experts to the enlarged laboratories' organization will shortly be announced.

In pointing out that all organization re-arrangements are intended to increase the strength and flexibility of the laboratories' technical support provided to expanding Air Force space weapons programs, Dr. Woodbridge revealed that only research, design and technical study types of activities are its predecessor, the guided missile research division, Space Technology Laboratories will engage in no manufacturing operations, its objective being to serve the government and its production contractors in the vital field of space weapon systems.

Changes Told
Ramo-Woodbridge Corp. executive changes, reflecting the importance of the Space Technology Laboratories' role, were also announced by Dr. Woodbridge.


Probation Dept. Opens Doors to Public Friday

This free service, which takes only 10 minutes total time, is being provided for students by members of the Harbor College Engines classes under the supervision of Instructor F. James Clines and Traffic Control Officer Guy Taylor. Car owners are responsible for removing and re-installing their own equipment.

Prevention of auto accessory theft, by providing a method of tracing thieves and pilferers is the aim of the new program. Car accessories worth \$1,000,000 are stolen annually in the city of Los Angeles, \$50,000 worth in the Harbor Area alone.

BUFFET DINNER IS EASY
A buffet is probably the most popular way to entertain at dinner. Certainly, it is the easiest way. Careful planning and advance preparation will insure your guests — and you, too — a mighty fine time.


Select dishes that may be completely or partly made ahead. Be sure the food is all fork food — no large pieces that require knife cutting. And make certain that the whole main course fits on one large dinner plate.

A fine casserole is ideal for the main dish at a buffet dinner. Make it hot, hearty, and delicious and be sure to allow for seconds. Round out the menu with a crisp-textured salad, tasty relishes and crusty hot rolls. Top off the meal with a luscious dessert and plenty of good hot coffee.

PARTY CASSEOLE
1 8-oz. pkg. wide noodles
6 hard-cooked eggs, coarsely chopped
3 to 4 C. chopped cooked chicken, ham, or seafood
1/2 C. minced onion
1/2 C. sweet pickle relish
1 4-oz. can mushrooms, stems and pieces
1/2 C. butter
1/2 C. flour
2 tsp. salt
1 tsp. pepper
1 tsp. Worcestershire
2 Tbsp. lemon juice
2 C. chicken broth or bouillon
2 C. milk
1 5-oz. pkg. potato chips
Cook noodles in boiling salted water until just tender. Drain color with a bright sprinkle of green or red colored sugar.

PUMPKIN CHIFFON PIE
1 C. brown sugar
3 egg yolks, slightly beaten
1 1/2 C. canned pumpkin
1/2 C. milk
1/2 tsp. ginger
1/2 tsp. allspice
2 tsp. cinnamon
1 envelope unflavored gelatine
3 Tbsp. cold water
3 egg whites, stiffly beaten
2 Tbsp. sugar
Baked pie shell
Combine brown sugar, egg yolks, pumpkin, milk, salt and spices in a saucepan. Cook, stirring constantly, over low flame until mixture thickens. Soften gelatine in cold water and stir into hot mixture. Cool until slightly thickened. Fold in meringue made from egg whites and 2 Tbsp. sugar. Pour into baked pie shell. Chill until firm.

PARTY TOP FOR PUMPKIN PIE
Flavor lightly sweetened whipped cream with rum or brandy, flavoring and serve it on chilled pumpkin pie. Add a touch of gay water until just tender. Drain color with a bright sprinkle of green or red colored sugar.
