"We have non-governmental representation on the UN and work for the promotion of world peace."

"You can walk in the door of a YWCA in the United States or abroad and even if they are speaking another language you feel that these are your friends, they too are members of the YWCA."

"Then of course the foreign work must be supported," Miss Duke continued. "We are now working in 70 countries. The newest country to have YWCA work is Ethiopia. The YWCAs of the United States do not support the work in all countries."



