### State Approves Funds for New Osteopathic Hospital

Success of a fund drive to build a \$1,100,000 Bay Harbor Osteopathic Hospital on a six-acre site at Lomita Blvd. and President Ave. was reported yesterday when hospital leaders were notified that the project had qualified for \$594,882 in Hill-Burton Funds.

Glenn Wymore, San Pedro attorney, president of the hospital board of directors, received the notice from John Derry, assistant chief of the Bureau of Hospitals, State Department of Public Health, in Berkeley. Wymore, with Dr. Donald Cortum, Redondo Beach and Torrance, hospital board secretary; Dr. George Wall, San Pedro, fund drive chairman; and Charles F. Crawford, director and publicity chairman, presented the hospital fund drive report to state officials in Berkeley.

**Pledges Revealed**

A total of \$418,000 in pledges was secured by a corps of volunteer workers during the four-month campaign, Wymore told state officials. He also presented evidence to the group showing that the hospital drive expects to have more than \$300,000 in cash on hand by March, 1959, when bids must be asked on the new 50-bed facility.

Hospital leaders said that the drive will probably be continued to secure additional funds for acquisition of land and equipment. Hugh Davies, Long Beach architect for the new hospital, is expected to present surveys and soil corings to state officials within the next two weeks and will have line drawings of the building prepared for State Bureau of Hospitals inspection by Feb. 1, 1958.

The new hospital with emergency and out patient facilities will employ more than 125 persons and have a payroll of more than \$50,000 per month when completed.
