### Lomita Library Bids Rejected

Bids on the proposed new Lomita library were thrown out this week by the County Board of Supervisors after Supervisor Burton W. Chace complained that the methods employed by the county in procuring bids failed to provide sufficient competition among bidders.

The County Property Management Dept. has recommended awarding a contract for the proposed new Lomita library to Dr. Meyer R. Tittleman and Sidney J. Freeman.

Following the testimony before the board which indicated that only three firms had been invited to bid on the new 5,000 square-foot facility, the Board instructed Property Manager R. B. Heurer to secure a transferable option on a suitable site convenient to Lomita schools and advertise for bids through newspaper publication.

Chace pointed out that completion of the library will provide a considerable better service to residents in the Lomita area, with 25,000 books

available for circulation, 5,000 of them for children. It is expected that circulation of books will be doubled by the larger facilities.

The present library, which is located at 24704 Narbonne Ave., will be abandoned by the county after the new facilities become available, Chace said.
