On tour of American Security installations at the invitation of the United States Government, the Turkish guests left for Washington, D. C. Tuesday following a whirlwind tour of the Southland.

A press conference was held in the Torrance Chamber of Commerce office before the "informal" dinner officiated by Press Chairman Ray Sloan.
