

Assemblyman Seeks Complaints About Poor Telephone Service

By CHARLES E. CHAPEL Assemblyman, 46th District Recently the California State Public Utilities Commission granted rate increases to some public utilities. The Assembly Committee on Public Utilities and Corporations, of which I have been a member for many years, and was a chairman for

two years, has no control over the Public Utilities Commission in the strict sense of the term. We can hold public hearings which will bring forth witnesses and testimony not presented to the Public Utilities Commission, we can recommend laws governing the Commission to the Legislature (and have done so frequently), and we can make recommendations to the Governor regarding the appointment and re-appointment of the members of the Public Utilities Commission, some of which the Governor heeds and some of which he ignores. Nevertheless, we can start a chain of events that will ultimately help the people of California.

Money Needed Various telephone companies complained in seeking rate increases that they needed more money to hire more people and buy more equipment. My idea is that they should demonstrate that they can and will give better service with the people and the equipment which they already have and then seek rate increases, but the telephone companies and other public utilities insist they need rate increases and I want it clearly understood that this is not the act of the Legislature, but in spite of and contrary to the attitude of many members of both the Assembly and the Senate.

This is serious because if a person's house is on fire or if a doctor is needed in a hurry, those minutes may mean the difference between life and death. In order to get better service, I need written, detailed complaints from people, mailed to me at P.O. Box 777, Inglewood 5. I shall send these complaints to the top management of the General Telephone Co. by registered mail and ask them what they intend to do to improve service. The operators and the men maintaining the lines tell me that it is not their fault, that fault lies in top management. If you are getting bad service from the General Telephone Co., do not suffer in silence but let me have your written complaints and we shall try to get action.

Card Trouble I keep a card file of people I know personally and try to send them Christmas cards but in spite of my best efforts to address the cards carefully and use three-cent stamps, the post office returns some of them with a rubber stamp reading "unknown at this address," or "moved, left no forwarding address," etc. This year most of those returned were addressed to people that I know very well are alive and getting mail at some address. 1. Taxes. Do you agree with me that the State should not levy any new taxes and should not increase any existing taxes or do you want taxes raised for some special project?
2. Water. Do you agree with me that we should not vote money for the California Water Plan, alias Feather River Project, if it does not guarantee water for Southern California and if it means more taxes?
3. Careless Driving. Do you agree with me that we need stricter laws regarding speeding, drunk driving, and other motor vehicle problems?
4. Narcotics. Do you agree with me that we need stricter laws regarding narcotics?
