A case and a half of wine and three windows were reported stolen from a coffee shop at 3103 Pacific Coast Hwy., local police said yesterday.


The wine value was estimated at \$12 while the louvered windows were estimated to cost \$75.

### Hughes Aircraft Grants Increase In Hourly Pay

Approximately 18,500 Hughes Aircraft Co. employees will receive a cost-of-living wage increase of one cent an hour effective Saturday, it was announced yesterday by company officials.

The new raise brings total wage raises during the past year to eight cents an hour, based on the cost of living index, according to William W. Woolridge, vice president and assistant general manager of the firm.

### Aircraft Firm Gets Contract For \$900,000

The Australian government's Department of Defense this week ordered in excess of \$900,000 worth of North American Aviation designed F-86 parts from the aircraft company's Los Angeles division.

The Sabre Jet parts will be shipped to the Commonwealth Aircraft Corp. of Australia which recently received a contract to build additional Avon Sabres for first line fighter-interceptor duty with the RAAF.

CAC since early 1951 has been manufacturing Australian versions of the Sabre Jet.

Engineering and manufacturing relationship between North American and the Australian company dates back to 1937 when CAC in its initial production line build the "Wirraway," a version of the T-6 Texan trainer.

Early in 1943, CAC received a contract from the Australian government to manufacture the CA-17 which was a model of North American's F-51D Mustang.

In addition to the Commonwealth Aircraft Corp., Mitsubishi Heavy Industries of Japan, Canadair Limited of Canada, and the Fiat Company of Italy are manufacturing versions of the F-86 Sabre Jet under license.

### County Buys Golf Course On Peninsula

Purchase of land for a 173-acre golf course on the Palos Verdes Peninsula at a cost of \$1,360,000 was approved Thursday by the County board of supervisors.

Supervisor Burton W. Chase said the area will be developed into an 18-hole tournament course serving the southwest county area. The land was acquired from the Rancho Palos Verdes Corp. and the Capital Co.

Purchase of the property at the appraised price determined by two independent experts was recommended by Robert Heuer, the county's real estate director.

Property for the new course fronts on Crest Road on the southwest slopes of the peninsula, and has been described as one of the most beautiful golf course sites in the west.
