

Pensioners Offered Tips For Determining Income

Income accounting time is here again for veterans and widows and children of veterans receiving pensions from the Veterans Administration, and Sara R. Evans, director, Torrance Area Veterans Service Center at 1622 Gramercy Ave., stands ready to help in defining income according to VA rules.

An income no greater than \$1400 per year allows a single veteran to maintain his pension eligibility. He must be totally and permanently disabled as the result of disease or injuries of a non-service connected source. If he has dependents, he must not have income of more than \$2700 annually—over and above his

VA pension.

Other Incomes
But "income" in the VA regulations is defined in various ways, and veterans are urged to avail themselves of the assistance and know-how of Mrs. Evans in making out the questionnaires being sent to them by the VA. The definitions include Social Security,

life insurance, retirement pay, income from rent or sale of property, and the like.

For instance, if a veteran is on a VA pension and applies for Social Security disability insurance, the amount of his pension will be deducted from the check to be sent to him by Social Security. And Social Security payments will count

to be accounted for on the VA questionnaire.

"Answers on the pension-income questionnaire must be to the VA's satisfaction, or there is danger of a suspension in pension payments," warns Mrs. Evans.

And VA pensioners are reminded again that they must notify the VA immediately if it appears their annual income in the year is going to exceed the limits.




