

Pitchess Seeks Sheriff's Job

Undersheriff Pete Pitchess has announced that he will be a candidate to succeed Eugene W. Biscailuz as Sheriff of Los Angeles County at the June 3 primary election.

For the past five years as undersheriff, Pitchess has been chief executive officer under Sheriff Biscailuz in administering the largest Sheriff's department in the United States.

Pitchess spent 12 years as a special agent for the Federal Bureau of Investigation, heading the criminal investigation section of the Los Angeles office during his later years with the FBI.

Pitchess said in his announcing statement: "It has been a deeply appreciated personal privilege to serve under Sheriff Gene Biscailuz, who is truly California's most beloved public official, held in high esteem by those of every race, color and creed and every economic and social station in life."

"Now that the Sheriff will retire, I anticipate the challenge of continuing the high standards of integrity and efficiency which he has maintained," Pitchess continued.

"There is only one campaign issue, and that is good law enforcement. Los Angeles County, growing fast and already bursting with almost six million people, must have able and honest law enforcement, because good law enforcement builds good government."

Hoodlums Warned

"It is well known that Los Angeles is considered the nation's richest plum by hoodlum elements which would like to take over such a lush prospect for gambling, vice, and lawlessness. My policies have been and will always be unending, uncompromising warfare against all such elements. The best weapon against them is sound, professional law enforcement carried out day by day," Pitchess said.

A native of Salt Lake City, Utah, and alumnus of the University of Utah, Pitchess is

married and has two children, Andrew, 14 and John, 15.

He announced a citizens' committee is being formed to back his candidacy, and the campaign chairman and headquarters will be announced in a short time.

Chest Drive Volunteers Lauded Here

As the final reports were made, 4000 Harbor Community Chest volunteers under the leadership of Jay A. Robinson, area chairman, were applauded for raising a 102 per cent of quota during the recent campaign on behalf of 187 member agencies.

In this final report of the welfare federation board of directors, Courtland S. Gross, retiring campaign chairman, stated that the Harbor area was one of the four associated cities to raise a 100 per cent of their goal.

In all, 80,000 Los Angeles Community Chest volunteers raised a total of \$10,123,359 in their annual appeal. The total is nearly 99 per cent of the \$10,300,000 campaign goal and is a new record high in fund raising for health and welfare here, according to Ernest J. Loebbeck, president of the Chest. Last year's Chest total was \$9,953,652.

Steve Broidy, president of Allied Artists, who will lead the 1958-59 appeal, outlined campaign plans for board approval.
